






Information about the study

How the study works



	<p>Some people will keep taking the same strength of tablets</p>





	<p>Some people will take weaker tablets</p>


What will you need to do

	<p>Your doctor will give you tablets</p>
	<p>You will need to take the tablets</p>



	<p>You and your carers will need to fill in a questionnaire about your behaviour</p>
	<p>You will visit your doctor 5 times with carers to see how you are doing</p>
	<p>You will meet the research team 5 times and fill in a questionnaire</p>
	<p>No bloods are taken</p>

What if my behaviour gets worse?



	<p>If your behaviour gets worse your carers will tell your doctor</p>

Will I get anything for taking part?
